

Minutes from October 14, 2014

Meeting was called to order at 7:03 p.m. by President Jennifer Smith. Tim White made a motion to approve September minutes. Roseanne Henley seconded the motion. Minutes were approved as submitted.

Marching Season is off to a great start. The band did great at Potosi. We have received very high scores at our competitions.

Treasurer Anne Fegan gave the financial report. Approximately  $\frac{1}{4}$  of band fees have been collected. Please make sure band fees are paid. This is a trip year and fees must be paid in order for band members to go on the trip. The Entertainment Book fundraiser made \$3000. This money has been distributed to student accounts and the general fund. The Kona Ice Truck made \$403 at the first couple of football games for the general fund. Money was transferred from the Scrip account to the general fund. We have paid for this year's drill (\$3,147 which is less than last year's show cost). Currently, our account balance is \$14,826.

Janet Schott, Scrip Coordinator, gave the Scrip report. Scrip are gift cards that are purchased for the face value on the cards. Our organization pays less for the cards. The difference is put into individual student band accounts and the general fund. Online ordering of Scrip is also available. Scrip will be sold outside the band room on Thursday evenings during marching season (October 23 will be the last evening for Thursday sales) and on Saturdays at the conclusion of marching season (check the website for location of Saturday sales). Currently, the Scrip account has a balance of \$5,572.10 and there is \$13,616.00 of Scrip cards on hand.

Cheesecake fundraiser went well. Pickup for cheesecakes will be October 16, 4-6 p.m.

This coming weekend will be busy with BOA on Friday evening and Mizzou on Saturday. Students will receive a snack after they perform on Friday (performance at 4:15 p.m.). Students will be fed lunch (after prelim performance) and dinner on Saturday (prelim performance at 12:45 on Saturday).

Up and coming events:

October 23 will be the last Thursday evening rehearsal. October 25 is UCM Marching Festival and band breakfast. More details about the band breakfast will be coming soon.

Trivia night was scheduled for November 7, but venue fell through. Watch for more information on this event. Boosters may wait until after the first of the year to host Trivia Night.

There was no director's report as the band was practicing due to a change in the normal Thursday evening practice schedule.
