The October Holt Band Booster meeting was called to order at 7:01 pm by Booster President, Carol Dalton. In attendance were: Lori Weber, Katy Miles, Jill Poyser, Kim Pieper, Jennifer & Mike Hinman, Rita & Sean Witte, Stephanie Struckmann, Carol Dalton, Cindy Jenkins, Chris Meyer, Traci Morlock, Jacob England, and Jim Cunningham.

Jill Poyser made a motion to approve the September minutes. Traci Morlock seconded the motion and the minutes were approved.

Chris Meyer gave the Treasurer's Report. Major expenditures this month were: \$10,000 for music/drill/entry fees, \$6800 for fundraising, \$3000 for Color Guard, \$2700 for transportation & fuel, \$2000 for uniforms, \$1100 for competition food, and \$1000 for props. Major income for the month was: \$7600 in fundraising, \$3000 in student fees, \$2800 in Spirit Wear Sales, and \$1600 in donations.

Cindy Jenkins gave the Scrip Report. \$4,190.00 was sold in Scrip this month. Student accounts earned \$361.84 and the Band General Fund earned \$136.71. An average of about 30 people participate in Scrip every month. Using Scrip is a great way to earn money towards band fees and money for the band as a whole. It would be awesome if we could get more people to use the program.

Traci Morlock gave the Uniform Report. Some uniforms had to go out for cleaning. Please do not use Shout wipes on the uniforms, they leave watermarks. If a student has a mark or stain, please have them show Traci so she can take care of it. Traci will be bagging uniforms for Potosi on Thursday night. If you can help on Thursday, come to the band room, we will put you to work. Your help is so appreciated.

Jill Poyser gave the Pit Report. Scrim and Silouettes are finished and will be traveling to Potosi with the band. Thanks to all who helped put Silouettes and Scrim together. Trucks for Potosi are being picked up Friday afternoon and will be loaded Friday evening at 5 pm. Some students will be helping load trucks, but we could use additional assistance if you're free Friday evening. We will need more parent help in Potosi, as we now have 7 silhouettes we need to get on the field.

Katy Miles gave the Fundraising Report. Candy bar sales still ongoing. Cardinal Calendars, DQ night, Mod Pizza Night, Applebees, 5 Below Fundraiser, and Poinsettias all coming up. Stephanie will send out more info as the dates get closer.

Carol Dalton gave the Spirit Wear Update. New spirit wear will be ordered and available at the Christmas concert.

Becky Ginger gave the Color Guard Report. New uniforms and flags are in and look amazing. Color Guard will also be having some upcoming fundraisers at DQ on 10/15 and Applebees on 10/24.
