

## November 13th Band Booster Meeting Minutes

Jill Poyser Made a motion to approve the October Minutes as submitted. Anne Dietz seconded and October minutes were approved.

Chris Meyer gave the Treasurer's Report. Major expenditures for the month were: \$4,000 for music & instruction, \$2,700 for food, \$1600 for Uniforms, Transportation \$1500, Color Guard \$1200, Lodging for bus drivers \$500. Major income for the month: Student Fees \$4200, Spirit Wear Sales \$1700, Texas Roadhouse/Nut Sale \$690, Color Guard Fundraiser \$670, Donations \$278, Kona Ice \$115, Sept Scrip \$361

The band has several upcoming expenses that need to be paid, so it is imperative that all student fees be paid ASAP. Students have outstanding band fees in excess of \$30,000.

Chris Meyer also gave the Scrip Report. Total Scrip Sales for October were 15,696.09 Most of this was online sales and an increase from last month. \$477.74 of this went to student accounts and \$168.26 went to the band general fund.

Traci Morlock gave the uniform report. Marching uniforms and tuxedo jackets will be taken to cleaners in January. Dress & Tux fittings for Freshmen will be in December. Please have all students try on their concert attire to make sure they fit. If they need new sizes please let us know and they too can be measured in December.

Jill Poyser gave the Pit Report. All equipment has been winterized. Thanks to all who helped with organizing equipment and winterizing. Entrance ramps to building need to be repaired/replaced.

Katy Miles gave the fundraising report. Candy Bar/Mod Pizza/Cardinal Calendar sales are all completed. Candy money needs to be turned in NOW.

Poinsettia Sales are ongoing and end on November 19th. Plants will be delivered on November 29th. Upcoming Fundraisers are: Dairy Queen November 20th and Five Below November 22-28. After that we will chill on the fundraising and are looking to have some type of event, like a craft fair, in the Spring. Thank you to all who have participated in the fundraisers.

Debi Steber gave the Spirit Wear update. We are pretty much sold out of all spirit wear that was ordered this year. Blankets can be ordered until November 26th. We have reordered some items and they will be available to purchase at the Winter Concert.

Becky Ginger gave the Color Guard Report. Color Guard is now Winter Guard. The Winter Guard has several upcoming competitions. The guard received a generous donation of \$2500 from the Wentzville Community Club recently.

Mr. Cunningham and Mr. England gave the directors' report. Thanks to everyone for another great season. 5 band members were selected for District Band this year. Jazz Band has begun. There was a lot of interest in Jazz Band this year. Because of this, there are 2 Jazz Bands this year, or a Jazz Band and a Jazz Lab. It should be an exciting jazz year.
