The meeting was called to order at 6:07 by Band Booster President, Carol Dalton. Jill Poyser made a motion to approve the November minutes and Mary Wood seconded the motion and the November minutes were approved.

Chris Meyer gave the treasurer's report for November/December. Total income was \$21,100 and total expenditures were \$29,300. Brief monthly financial statements are printed and available at the monthly booster meetings. This month the band has to make the first payment for BOA 2019.

\*Student fees should all be paid and are overdue at this point. Many students still have outstanding balances that must be paid.

Cindy Jenkins gave the scrip report. November sales were: \$20,556. Profit was \$1074.61 with \$805.87 going to student accounts and \$121.21 going to the band general fund. For December, total sales were \$38,701. \$20,00.00 of that was purchased by a company who does not have a child in the band and is not affiliated with the band. Student accounts for December earned \$671. Scrip financial reports are also printed and available at the monthly booster meetings.

Uniform Report was given by Traci Morlock. Marching uniforms and tux jackets will be sent out to be cleaned this month. All measurements have been taken for concert clothes. Any boys still needing new concert pants or shirts will need to go to Savvi Formal Wear at Mid Rivers Mall to be measured. Dresses and Tuxes have been ordered and will need to be paid for before students will receive them. Chris Meyer will be putting in Tux & Dress fees soon, so you can log on to Charms and pay the \$65 fee. You can also send in check or cash if you need to.

Jill Poyser gave the Pit Report. Storage trailer has been cleaned and organized. Not much going on with pit right now since marching season is over.

Carol Dalton gave the Spirit Wear Report. Sales at the Christmas Concert were great.

Katy Miles was unable to attend tonight's meeting so all fundraising numbers available at the next meeting.

Becky ginger gave the Color Guard Report. Winter Guard is in full swing, practicing for Winter competitions. Winter Guard uniforms have been ordered.
