

The March Holt Band Booster meeting was called to order at 7:05 by President, Carol Dalton.

Cindy Jenkins gave the scrip reports for Jan and Feb since there wasn't a Feb meeting. January Scrip sales were \$13,325.50 with \$343.63 going to student accounts and \$89.53 going to general band fund.

February Scrip sales were \$13,405. 41 Student accounts were credited \$341.69 and \$88.27 to general band fund.

Carol Dalton gave the Treasurer's Report. Income for the month was \$8,089, mainly from student fees. Expenditures totaled \$8376.24. The bulk of that was \$4,683 for uniforms and \$2,250 for Guard instruction. The statement reflects only the month of February. Mr. Cunningham says, not worry there is money in the bank.

Jeff Loomis gave the mattress fundraiser presentation. The Wentzville Holt Indian Band 3rd Annual Mattress Fundraiser will take place on May 11th from 10-5. The Holt band had 17 students made state finals at the District Solo/Duo/Trio/Quartet contest held at Fort Zumwalt East on March 9th.
