Jill Poyser made a motion to approve the September booster meeting minutes as written. Cindy Jenkins seconded this motion and the September minutes were approved.

Becky Ginger gave the Color Guard Report. Uniforms are in and look awesome. The season is going great.

Rita Witte gave the V.P. Report. She restated the board's policy on making purchases for the band. All purchases, which require reimbursement, must be approved by the booster president, Carol Dalton or the booster treasurer, Jennifer Hinman. Purchases made without approval will not be reimbursed.

Jennifer Hinman gave the treasurer's report. The booster club is in the process of switching banks. You'll see some amounts on the monthly financial statement reflecting this, as we had to deposit money from the Commerce Bank account into the new MO Bank Account to get it started. Total deposits were \$23,900. Major income for the month: Candy bar fundraiser \$12,100, Student fees \$4,500

Total expenditures for the month were \$35,415. Major purchases were: \$8,300 Color Guard Choreography, gloves/shoes/flags, & instruction. \$6,600 Marching gloves/shoes, visual design, drill book. \$5,000 to start MO Bank Acct, \$4,400 to start MoBank Scrip Account. \$3,200 show shirts. \$2600 SIUE Festival. \$2,500 Blue Springs South transportation & hotel. \$970 Blue Springs South Food

Cindy Jenkins gave the Scrip Report. Total sales for September were: \$15,200. Student accounts were credited \$450, while the general band fund made \$118. Shop With Scrip will be having special bonus deals coming up for the holidays, be sure to watch your email for these.

Jill Poyser gave the Pit Report. Thank you to all the pit parents for your help. We have two pieces of pit equipment, marimba carts, which each need a new wheel. The pit will work on replacing at the next Thursday night rehearsal. The trailer tires are eight years old and will need to be replaced eventually. Something to keep in mind for future budget projections.

Christina Frecks gave the Fundraising Report.

*We have 100 boxes of candy left, which will be sold at the Holt & WMS Winter Concerts. The leftover boxes will be available for students to sell again in February. 204 boxes were sold, which made \$1500 for the band and \$4500 for student accounts.

*Mod Pizza Night earned the band \$236.00 The next Mod Pizza Night is December 19th.

*Our last DQ night netted \$189.00 The next DQ Night will be on November 5th.

*Poinsettia sales begin on Nov 1st & end on Nov 22nd. They will be delivered on Dec 5th.
